

Consistency the winner with EHMS

A web-based management system, designed to support the regulatory activities of environmental health services has been endorsed by the CIEH.

The system has been designed and produced by west Wales-based RH Environmental Limited, a company begun by EHP Rob Halford, former environmental health manager for Enfield Council.

Called EHMS, the system provides, online, all of the procedures and standard documents needed by an environmental health service, with legislation, national policy and guidance linked to each procedure. It is maintained by an editorial team and a panel of

specialist contributors. It has already been adopted by eight local authorities, including Ceredigion Council in Wales.

Graham Jukes, CIEH chief executive, commented: 'The CIEH is continually striving to support and help environmental health practitioners with all the information they need. One of the key attractions of EHMS is that it supports the drive coming out of the LBRO for consistency of enforcement across local authorities.'

Rob Halford of RH Environmental commented: 'I am delighted that the CIEH has recognised the potential

of this system. It was developed based on consultation with local authorities and the experience of practitioners and managers. It is unique and has been recognised as an essential tool to enable consistency across the profession.'
